

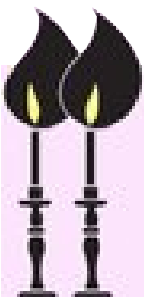



Smoked Fish Delivery at TBJ

We now have smoked fish available at TBJ on Sunday mornings. We're obtaining it from deli-man Richard Weisberg - who's at Washington St. Cafe on Sunday mornings - who gets the fish during frequent trips to Brooklyn. Selections include: Nova Lox, Whitefish salad and whole whitefish, herring fillets in homemade cream or wine sauce, smoked sable, kippered salmon, and sour pickles. Most are available in 1/4 pound increments, or as single serving bagel toppers to go with your Sunday-morning Sisterhood bagel. We're being good stewards of the environment by packaging in paper when possible - you're welcome to provide your own containers.

Price lists are available on Sunday mornings (during Religious School) at the door monitor's desk, and orders are due by the following Friday for Sunday delivery. Prices include approximately 10% for Sisterhood. To place your order, bring or mail the order form to TBJ (write checks to TBJ Sisterhood), or call/email Nancy Jo (746-5892, nchabot@tds.net).
